Inviting Young Adults to apply for the position of “Mission Intern” with the Church Mission Committee.

The Mission Committee guides our congregation to support and participate in Christian Missions in our local community, in our country and abroad. We work to advance the Kingdom of God addressing all sorts of needs and social issues and helping to spread the Christian faith among peoples here in the USA and around the world.

The “Mission Intern” will work with and assist the Mission Committee for nine months, from September 2024 to May 2025. The Intern will become knowledgeable of and participate in planning and carrying out our Mission Program. The Intern will:

- Attend the monthly meetings of the Mission Committee
- Assist with the Moment for Mission in the worship services
- Assist in mission communication with our congregation
- Assist in correspondence with mission organizations and missionaries
- Assist with planning and conducting various mission activities, events and trips

Commitment: The Intern will assist the Mission Committee with 10 hours of service each month, September through May. The Intern will receive a stipend of \$200 per month for these nine months.

Qualifications: Must be at least 18 years old and a high school graduate. Must show interest in Christian Missions. Past and present participation in First Pres Church of Newhall.

Application: Send your application as a statement, which may be a Word document or a handwritten document, in response to the following questions. Text responses are not acceptable. Your statement may be as long as you want and should share with the Mission Committee who you are and your interest in this Internship.

- What is your connection with First Pres Newhall? How have you participated in our community of faith?
- Provide a statement of your Christian belief and faith
- Share any experiences you have had with Christian missions, from childhood, youth, and as a young adult
- Why are you interested in this position? What talents and abilities do you have to contribute to the Mission Committee?
- Provide your contact information, your age, and your education
- State your commitment to Intern with the Committee for the entire period of nine months
- Provide a written recommendation from someone you know with your application. Share this invitation with that person.

Deliver or mail your written application in a sealed envelope to the Church, addressed to the attention of Johan Vandersande, Chair of the Mission Committee. Applications must be submitted by July 31st and the Mission Committee will interview the applicants and will make the selection of the Intern in August.
